COVID-19 Vaccination programme

- The vaccination programme is a significant national achievement, and it is a pleasure to playing a part in the process as the Government Minister with responsibility for the rollout
- I would like to thank all NHS staff and volunteers in Tysoe and the surrounds for the work they have done to facilitate such an excellent inoculation campaign
- Nationally, by 15 February, a first vaccine dose was offered to the first four cohorts, which in total consists of those above the age of 70 and all those on the shielding list
- We will now move on to cohorts 5-9, and aim to give these individuals their first dose by the end of April
- I am pleased to say that we are well into these latter cohorts in South Warwickshire, with the majority in Tysoe attending the vaccination centre in Wellesbourne
