TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TYSOE ROAD, TYSOE

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Tysoe Road, Tysoe, from the junction of A422 to the jct. Lower Tysoe Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for renewal of a water mains.

The Order will commence on 5 August 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3 September 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Lower Tysoe Road, Radway Road, Banbury Road, Tysoe Road, Lane End (and vice versa).
